

Privacy Notice

In accordance with Federal Regulations, each jurisdiction that receives local, State and/or Federal funding must have and enter data into a Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). Homeless Services Network of Central Florida, Inc. manages the Central Florida FL-507 Continuum of Care (CoC) HMIS. This Agency participates in the CoC FL-507 HMIS and Coordinated Entry System (CES).

This Agency uses HMIS to determine your needs and to provide a record for evaluating the services this Agency provides to you. We only collect information that is needed to provide you services, and only use or disclose your information with your informed consent, except when required by our funders, by law, or for specific administrative or research purposes outlined in our Privacy Plan. This information is shared with all Partner Agencies, unless specifically limited in writing. A list of Partner Agencies is available upon request.

The FL-507 CES is used to connect individuals and families at-risk of or experiencing homelessness to the services they need.

The collection and use of all of your personal information is protected by strict standards of confidentiality as outlined in our Privacy Plan as well as State and Federal laws. Your personally identifiable information will never be sold, or given to anyone outside of the FL-507 CoC.

A copy of the Central Florida CoC Privacy Plan, describing allowable uses and disclosures of data collected for the purposes of HMIS and/or CES, is available upon request for your review. This policy may be amended at any time and that amendments may affect information obtained before the date of the change.

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
